Namely is a cloud based platform, built on a single database and delivered as a SaaS based, multitenant solution. Its current configuration primarily supports North America; however, it also supports global employees in ~30 countries (for core HR and talent only) and ~20% of its current user base is international.

Today, Namely has ~500 employees, serves ~1k clients, and supports ~175k client employees through its HCM platform offering.
