NelsonHall's Managed Security Services profile on CSS Corp is a comprehensive assessment of CSS Corp's offerings and capabilities designed for:

- Sourcing managers monitoring the capabilities of existing suppliers of managed security services and identifying vendor suitability for security services RFPs
- Vendor marketing, sales, and business managers looking to benchmark themselves against their peers
- Financial analysts and investors specializing in the IT services sector.

Key Findings & Highlights

This NelsonHall vendor assessment analyzes CSS Corp's offerings and capabilities in managed security services.

Founded in 1996, CSS Corp is a privately held organization headquartered in Chennai that provides a number of services including remote infrastructure management, technology support, and cloud enablement.

In June 2013, The Partners Group acquired a controlling stake in CSS Corp, for \$270m.

CSS Corp has 5.5k FTEs across 16 locations globally, engaged in delivering remote infrastructure management and technology support services.

In 2014, CSS Corp launched its Cyber Attack Thwart Services (CATS), which are advanced security services that aim to preemptively reduce risks posed by threat actors. Version 2 of CATS, launched in 2015-2016 focused on advanced threat detection, but CSS Corp has since removed the versions and moved to a continuous improvement model for CATS.

The report provides a comprehensive and objective analysis of CSS Corp's managed security services offerings and capabilities, and market and financial strengths, including:

- Identification of the company's strategy, emphasis, and new developments
- Analysis of the company's strengths, weaknesses, and outlook
