Key Findings & Highlights

Efficio Ltd. is a U.K.-based procurement and supply chain services company, established in 2000 with offices globally. Efficio:

- Affirms to deliver up to 10x ROI
- Has ~650 employees engaged in procurement and supply chain-related activity with a focus on sourcing, supplier, and contract management
- Has a proprietary technology platform, eFlow, which combines source-to-contract functionality with a knowledge and insights platform
- Has subject matter experts to deliver improvements to the client's procurement function
- Does not offer standalone P2P services but bundles them in combination with sourcing services.

NelsonHall estimates that Efficio generated overall revenues of ~\$80m from procurement and supply chain consulting services in 2022. Efficio claims continued growth across all geographies in which it operates.

It has ~650 employees across 11 global offices. NelsonHall estimates that around 600 FTEs are procurement and supply chain consultants. The rest of the employees hold administrative and managerial roles. Approximately 150-200 employees are analysts supporting more experienced consultants. Efficio has a digital team supporting the eFlow platform and a knowledge management team supporting consultants with training and category insights.

Efficio is looking to expand its operations outside the U.K. The company opened a new office in December 2022 in Lisbon, Portugal. This expansion is a part of Efficio's strategy to grow its presence in Europe to support clients across geographies.
