Key Findings & Highlights

Neeyamo is a technology-enabled global payroll and EOR solutions provider with an emphasis on serving the long-tail countries of multinationals, with payroll service coverage across 180 countries.

Neeyamo business supports ~300 clients in ~160 countries and is organized into two service lines (with an approximate share of revenue):

- Global managed payroll services and global payroll technology
 - Payroll services (85%)
 - HR outsourcing (15%), as an add-on offering for payroll clients
- Employer of Record (launched June 2022).

Since its inception, Neeyamo has developed proprietary tools to enable its HR services, dedicating ~25% of its annual revenues toward R&D efforts through Its wholly-owned subsidiary, NeeyamoWorks, which manages all technical development for enabling its HR service delivery.

Neeyamo supports payroll for ~160 countries, where currently ~75 country payrolls' gross-to-net is processed by its single global engine, Neeyamo Payroll. Neeyamo has been heavily investing in adding payrolls into its global payroll engine and aims to support ~100 countries within its native global engine by the end of 2022. Neeyamo has 173 payroll clients and delivers services to ~1m client employees.
