Key Findings & Highlights

The procurement BPO market remains small in comparison to other BPO markets but is potentially rapidly growing. Much of the inhibitor to market growth has been the lack of mature multi-geography, multi-category vendor capability but this impediment is starting to be removed with the acquisition of Procurian by Accenture and the acquisition of Portland Group by Infosys.
