Key Findings & Highlights

Safeguard Global, formed in 2006 and headquartered in Austin, Texas, is a global provider of managed payroll and employer of record services. Its business has the following divisions:

- Global managed payroll services, with ~343 clients, servicing 148k employees and 2.3m payslips p.a.
- Global employment outsourcing (Employee of Record, or EOR). EOR services include processing payroll alongside other HR processes, with ~ 930 clients, ~4,900 workers supported.

In January 2022, Safeguard Global acquired Global Upside Corporation, a comprehensive incorporation with services including PEO/EOR, accounting, HR, payroll, compliance, entity setup, and M&A services. The Global Upside EOR services include the running of payroll for EOR employees. The country footprint across both organizations is well aligned. This acquisition added ~500 employees to the 1,100 Safeguard Global employees to create a combined organization of ~1,600 employees. Global Upside is in the process of being rebranded as Safeguard Global, with completion expected at the end of Q3, 2022.

Today, Safeguard Global supports payroll services for ~343 clients and ~148k active employees across ~170 countries. It currently processes ~2.3m payslips annually, supported by ~730 payroll delivery employees. This profile focuses exclusively on Safeguard Global's Payroll Services offering and capability.
